Fr. Bruce Wren received a Bachelor's Degree of Liberal Arts in the Great Books program at St. John's College. He joined the Legion of Christ and completed two years of classical humanities studies in Salamanca, Spain. He finished his priestly formation in Rome, at the Pontifical Athenaeum Regina Apostolorum, where he received licentiate degrees in philosophy and theology. After ordination, he began priestly ministry as Instructor of Novices in the French-speaking novitiate in Cornwall, Canada. He was Rector of the Apostolic School in France and Superior of the Community from 1999 until 2014, when he received a new assignment in Chicago, as Chaplain of the Lumen Institute and auxiliary to the Regnum Christi Men's section.



Dr. Lisa Fortini-Campbell is an Adjunct Professor in the Executive Education programs at the Kellogg School of Management at Northwestern University where she specializes in courses on customer psychology and integrating the customer experience. She lectures on those topics in open enrollment programs on Branding, Customer Insight Tools, and Creating the Market-Focused Organization -- a program for which she is the co-Academic Director. She also teaches in a wide variety of customized executive education programs for companies. Lisa is also the president and managing director of The Fortini-Campbell Company, a marketing consulting firm in Evanston, Illinois, which she founded in 1990.
