He completed post graduate training residencies in Internal Medicine and Pediatrics followed by Fellowships in Adult Cardiology and Clinical Cardiac Electrophysiology. He is a Partner at Heart Care Centers of Illinois and Director of the Electrophysiology Lab at MetroSouth Medical Center in Blue Island. In private practice, he mainly provides services related



to restoring heart rhythms back to normal including insertion of pacemakers and defibrillators and catheter ablations.
